Read John 14, then answer the following questions about verses 15-27.

What does the Holy Spirit do for us?

Pronounce It – Read through the verse multiple times emphasizing a different keyword each time. Use the ***Pronounce It*** technique on 14:27a: “Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you.” As you emphasize each word in the verse, write down your thoughts about what each of those words means.

What do you think Jesus means by “I do not give to you as the world gives” in verse 27?

Where are your hearts “troubled”? In other words, what struggles and fears do you need the Spirit to help you with? How would your life be different if you had peace instead of fears and troubles.
