RELATE

Who do you go to when you need advice? Why? What makes a good “advisor”?

READ AND REFLECT

Read John 14:15-27, then answer the following questions:

- How do we show love to Jesus?
- Who did Jesus promise to send to us?
- Where does the Holy Spirit live? See 1 Corinthians 6:19-20.
- What does the Holy Spirit do for us?
- **Pronounce It** – Read through the verse multiple times emphasizing a different keyword each time. Share your thoughts from the **Pronounce It** exercise on 14:27a: “Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you.”
- What do you think Jesus means by “I do not give to you as the world gives” in verse 27?
- Where are your hearts “troubled”? In other words, what struggles and fears do you need the Spirit to help you with? How would your life be different if you had peace instead of fears and troubles?

RESPOND

Choose one of the following resolutions to keep until the next class:

- Make a list of all the gifts (talents) God has given you. Choose one and figure out how you can use it to tell others about Jesus.
- Make a list of five people you will trust to give you good advice when you need it. Share the list with one person on the list, then keep it handy in case you need it.
